2. Once the deposit is received, your spot is on hold until you complete the camper's 4-H on-line enrollment information at:

The online enrollment with a deposit, will confirm a camping spot.

Camp Fees:

The total <u>cost per child is \$350</u> and includes all expenses with the exception of souvenirs and snacks. The fee covers overnight lodging, meals, insurance, counselor and adult supervision, classes, program costs, and a camp tee shirt. You may pay in installments.

Registration Deadline:

Return the attached registration form to the Extension office, with a \$75.00 deposit, or full payment, between now and June 10, 2025. When Extension receives the deposit, you then register on-line to confirm your spot. The full balance is due by June 16, 2025. Payment options include payment in full, monthly payments and applying for scholarship.
